

4 Day Grace Period

Does the State of Montana allow the 4 day grace period in schools?

The answer is “Yes.”

Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommends that vaccine doses given up to 4 days before the minimum interval or age be counted as valid.

However, any doses administered 5 days or earlier than the minimum interval or age should not be counted as valid and be repeated as age appropriate.

If the 2nd dose of Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) was administered before the child is 4-6 yrs of age, you will need to make sure there are 4 weeks (28 days) in between the 1st dose and 2nd dose.

The 4-day grace period does not apply to this.
