### Summary of MMWR Week 27: Ending 07/06/2019

- **General Communicable Diseases:** Elevated blood lead (3), Coccidioidomycosis (1), Legionellosis (1)
- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (12), Cryptosporidiosis (2), Giardiasis (1), Salmonellosis (3), Shiga toxin producing *E. coli* [STEC] (1)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** Pertussis (8)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (69), Gonorrhea (29), Syphilis, latent (1), Syphilis, primary or secondary (1), HIV (0)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis C, chronic (13), Hepatitis B, chronic (2)
- **Zoonotic diseases:** (0)
- **Animal Rabies:** (0), Rabies PEP (6)

**Acute Flaccid Myelitis (AFM) Surveillance:** This week the CDC released a *Vital Signs* article about AFM cases reported in the United States in 2018. During 2018, 233 AFM cases were confirmed, including three in Montana. While the majority of AFM cases are in children, all Montana cases were adults. Prompt recognition, early specimen collection, and rapid reporting will expedite public health investigations and help characterize AFM. **Measles:** As of July 3, 1,109 measles cases have been reported from 28 states, an increase of 14 cases from the previous week. There are no measles cases in Montana.

**West Nile Virus:** We are moving into the season of concern for WNV. To date, we have not had any human or equine cases of WNV reported. We are in our 4th week of testing mosquito samples for WNV. We have not yet had a positive sample for WNV. We have received mosquito samples from a total of 22 counties. Counties that have submitted mosquito specimens for WNV testing include: Big Horn, Blaine, Broadwater, Custer, Fergus, Flathead, Gallatin, Hill, Judith Basin, Lewis and Clark, Meagher, Missoula, Phillips, Pondera, Powell, Prairie, Ravalli, Sheridan, Teton, Valley, Wheatland, and Yellowstone.
