Summary of MMWR Week 35: Ending 8/31/2019

- **General Communicable Diseases:** Elevated blood lead (0)
- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (8), Cryptosporidiosis (2), Giardiasis (1), Salmonellosis (5), Shiga toxin producing *E. coli* [STEC] (3)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** *Haemophilus influenzae*, invasive (1), Mumps (1), Pertussis (3), Varicella [chickenpox] (1)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (92), Gonorrhea (35), Syphilis, latent (3), HIV¹ (0)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis C, chronic (90), Hepatitis C, acute (1)
- **Zoonotic diseases:** Q Fever, chronic (1)
- **Animal Rabies:** (1, bat)

West Nile Virus: No additional human or equine cases of WNV were reported this week. Montana has had a total of two neuroinvasive WNV cases reported year-to-date. CDEpi continues to investigate possible cases of West Nile.

Activity as of 9/05/2019:

- 3 Human cases
 - 2 neuroinvasive (Lewis and Clark, Custer)
 - 1 viremic blood donor (Yellowstone)
- 2 Equine cases
 - Lake Co (no travel, vaccinated)
 - Flathead Co (no travel, unknown vax status)
- 7 counties with positive mosquito testing
 - Blaine, Cascade, Lake, Lewis and Clark, Sheridan, Yellowstone, Valley
