Summary of MMWR Week 50 for the state of Montana: Ending 12/14/2019

- **General Communicable Diseases:** Legionellosis (1)
- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (5), Cryptosporidiosis (1), Giardiasis (1), Salmonellosis (1), Shigellosis (1),
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** *Haemophilus influenzae* invasive [type a] (1), Influenza hospitalization or death¹ (2), Pertussis (3), *Streptococcus pneumoniae* invasive (4)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (94), Gonorrhea (39), Syphilis (1), Syphilis latent (2), HIV (3)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis B chronic (1), Hepatitis C chronic (27)

Measles: Recent measles cases have raised concerns about potential exposures for those traveling through Denver and LA during the past week. In both settings, unvaccinated individuals were returning from international travel while infectious. To date, 1,276 cases of measles have been reported from 31 states in the U.S. with no cases in Montana.

Weekly activity: Chlamydia and gonorrhea cases were reported at average levels. Syphilis reports were well above average.
