- **General Communicable Diseases:** (0)
- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (4), Cryptosporidiosis (4), Giardiasis (3), Salmonellosis (2), Shiga toxin producing E. coli [STEC] (2)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** *Haemophilus influenzae*, invasive (1), Influenza hospitalization or death (33), Streptococcus pneumoniae, invasive (2), Varicella [chickenpox] (1)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (77), Gonorrhea (27), Syphilis, latent (3), syphilis, primary or secondary (2), HIV (0)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis C, chronic (17), hepatitis C, acute (1)
- **Tuberculosis:** Latent Tuberculosis Infection (2)
