Summary of MMWR Week 17: Ending 4/25/2020

- **General Communicable Diseases:** Elevated blood lead (1)
- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (8), Salmonellosis (3), Shiga toxin-producing *E. coli* (STEC) (1)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** *Streptococcus pneumoniae*, invasive (1), Pertussis (1)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (42), Gonorrhea (20), Syphilis, latent (1)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis B, chronic (2), Hepatitis C, chronic (5)
