Summary of MMWR Week 28 for the state of Montana: Ending 07/17/2021

- **General Communicable Diseases:** Latent TB Infection (LTBI) (6)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis C, chronic (18)
- **Metal Exposure:** Elevated Blood Lead (3)
- **Zoonotic Diseases:** Rabies, animal (1), Rabies, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (23)
- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (5), Giardiasis (3), Salmonellosis (2), Shiga toxin-producing *Escherichia coli* (STEC) (5), Shigellosis (1), Vibriosis (2)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (78), Gonorrhea (22), Syphilis, primary or secondary (4)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** *Streptococcus pneumoniae*, invasive (2), *Haemophilus influenzae*, invasive (1), Varicella (Chickenpox) (1)
- **Vectorborne Diseases:** Colorado Tick Fever (1), Tularemia (1)

COVID-19:

Montana is reporting 115,255 cases of COVID-19 as of 10:00 am 7/23/2021. Of these, 5,639 individuals have been hospitalized and 1,695 have died. For more details, check out our weekly COVID report, attached below. As of 7/23/2021, Montana is reporting **885,996** total vaccine doses administered and processed into imMTrax. The total number of fully vaccinated persons is now **439,781**. The percent of the eligible population that is fully vaccinated is **48%**. ***CDEpi is requesting specimens for all hospitalized COVID cases be sent to MTPHL for COVID sequencing. MTPHL has the capacity at this time to sequence all positive cases of concern, including hospitalized patients.***

West Nile Virus:

No human or equine cases of WNV have been reported yet this year. Montana has started trapping and testing mosquitoes for WNV. No positive mosquito pools have been detected yet this season. As of July 13th, 2021, a total of 11 WNV cases have been reported **nationally**.
