### Summary of MMWR Week 32 for the state of Montana: Ending 8/14/2021

- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (4), Cryptosporidiosis (1), Cyclosporiasis (1), Giardiasis (2), Salmonellosis (3), Shiga toxin-producing *Escherichia coli* (STEC) (2)
- **General Communicable Diseases:** Latent TB Infection (LTBI) (1), Elevated Blood Lead (2), Creutzfeldt-Jakob Disease (1)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis B, chronic (1), Hepatitis C, chronic (16)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (62), Gonorrhea (20)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** *Streptococcus pneumoniae*, invasive (4)
- **Vectorborne Diseases:** Lyme disease (2)\*
- **Zoonotic Diseases:** Rabies, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (2)

**COVID-19:** Over 37 million cases of COVID-19, including at least 624,213 deaths, have been reported in the U.S., with community-wide transmission identified across the nation. The percent of the eligible U.S. population with at least one vaccination is 72.7%. Montana is reporting 122,318 cases of COVID-19 as of 10:00 am 8/20/2021. Of these, 6,123 individuals have been hospitalized and 1,755 have died. To date, Montana is reporting 925,311 total vaccine doses administered and processed into imMTrax. The total number of fully vaccinated persons is now 455,014. The percent of the eligible population that is fully vaccinated is 49%.

**West Nile Virus:** Montana is still reporting zero human and equine cases of WNV to date this season. A total of **seven** positive mosquito pools have been identified this season. Counties with positive mosquito pools include Sheridan, Richland, McCone, Blaine, and Gallatin. Twenty-four counties have had mosquito pools tested for WNV. As of August 10th, 2021 a total of **40** WNV cases, 12 presumptive viremic blood donors, and 3 deaths have been reported **nationally**.
