Summary of MMWR Week 33 for the state of Montana: Ending 08/21/2021

- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (14), Cryptosporidiosis (1), Giardiasis (2), Salmonellosis (1), Shiga toxin-producing *Escherichia coli* (STEC) (1)
- **General Communicable Diseases:** Latent TB Infection (LTBI) (1)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis B, chronic (1), Hepatitis C acute (1), Hepatitis C, chronic (26)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (62), Gonorrhea (22)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** *Streptococcus pneumoniae*, invasive (3)
- **Vector-borne Diseases:** Colorado tick fever (2), Ehrlichiosis (1)
- **Zoonotic Diseases:** Rabies, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (9)

COVID-19: To date, over 38 million cases of COVID-19, including at least 632,786 deaths, have been reported in the U.S., with community-wide transmission identified across the nation. The percent of the eligible U.S. population with at least one vaccination is 73.7%. Montana is reporting 125,616 cases of COVID-19 as of 11:00 am 8/27/2021. Of these, 6,294 individuals have been hospitalized and 1,783 have died. Montana is reporting 938,418 total vaccine doses administered and processed into imMTrax. The total number of fully vaccinated persons is now 460,372. The percent of the eligible population that is fully vaccinated is 50%.

West Nile Virus: Montana is still reporting **zero human** cases of WNV to date this season. The **first equine** case was reported this week in Phillips County. A total of **eleven** positive mosquito pools have been identified this season. Counties with positive mosquito pools include Blaine, Gallatin, McCone, Prairie, Richland, Rosebud, and Sheridan. Twenty-seven counties have had mosquito pools tested for WNV. As of August 24th, 2021 a total of 102 WNV cases, 35 presumptive viremic blood donors, and 6 deaths have been reported **nationally**.
