### Summary of MMWR Week 35 for the state of Montana: Ending 9/4/2021

- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (6), Giardiasis (3), Salmonellosis (2), Shiga toxin-producing *Escherichia coli* (STEC) (7)
- **General Communicable Diseases:** Coccidioidomycosis (2), Elevated blood lead (1), Latent TB Infection (LTBI) (1)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis C, acute (1), Hepatitis C, chronic (19)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (60), Gonorrhea (23), Syphilis, primary or secondary (1)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** *Streptococcus pneumoniae*, invasive (1), Varicella (Chickenpox) (1)
- **Vector-borne Diseases:** Colorado tick fever (1)
- **Zoonotic Diseases:** Rabies, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (3)

**COVID-19:** To date, over 40 million cases of COVID-19, including at least 654,409 deaths, have been reported in the U.S., with community-wide transmission identified across the nation. The percent of the eligible U.S. population with at least one vaccination is 75.4%. Montana is reporting 133,715 cases of COVID-19 as of 11:00 am 9/10/2021. Of these, 6,679 individuals have been hospitalized and 1,834 have died. To date, Montana is reporting 963,464 total vaccine doses administered and processed into imMTrax. The total number of fully vaccinated persons is now 471,394. The percent of the eligible population that is fully vaccinated is 51%.

**West Nile Virus:** Montana is reporting its first human WNV case (neuroinvasive, Lewis and Clark) of the season. This case is associated with travel outside of Montana. One equine case has been reported this year (Phillips). A total of eleven positive mosquito pools have been identified this season. Counties with positive mosquito pools include Blaine, Gallatin, McCone, Prairie, Richland, Rosebud, and Sheridan. Twenty-seven counties have had mosquito pools tested for WNV. As of September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021 a total of 210 WNV cases, 78 presumptive viremic blood donors, and 9 deaths have been reported nationally.
