Summary of MMWR Week 36 for the state of Montana: Ending 9/11/2021

- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (7), Giardiasis (3), Salmonellosis (1), Listeriosis (1)
- **General Communicable Diseases:** Elevated blood lead (1), Latent TB Infection (LTBI) (1)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis C, chronic (13)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (60), Gonorrhea (25)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** *Streptococcus pneumoniae*, invasive (4), *Haemophilus influenzae*, invasive (1)
- **Vector-borne Diseases:** West Nile Virus (1), Lyme disease (2)
- **Zoonotic Diseases:** Rabies, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (2)

COVID-19: To date, over 41 million cases of COVID-19, including at least 666,440 deaths, have been reported in the U.S., with community-wide transmission identified across the nation. The percent of the eligible U.S. population with at least one vaccination is 76.1%. Montana is reporting 139,712 cases of COVID-19 as of 9:30 am 9/17/2021. Of these, 6,911 individuals have been hospitalized and 1,877 have died. To date, Montana is reporting 976,831 total vaccine doses administered and processed into imMTrax. The total number of fully vaccinated persons is now 477,447. The percent of the eligible population that is fully vaccinated is 51%.

Influenza: During the 2020-2021 flu season Montana reported NO flu cases that confirmed out at MTPHL. This was not for lack of testing—clinical labs tested over 21,000 specimens for flu. **If you hear of a case of influenza, please call CDEpi to coordinate confirmatory testing at MTPHL: 444-0273.** CDC's complete guidance for flu prevention is available online: <https://www.cdc.gov/flu/prevent/index.html>
