### Summary of MMWR Week 37 for the state of Montana: Ending 9/18/2021

- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (6), Giardiasis (2), Salmonellosis (1)
- **General Communicable Diseases:** Latent TB Infection (LTBI) (2); Legionellosis (2)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis C, chronic (12)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (60), Gonorrhea (26)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** *Streptococcus pneumoniae*, invasive (4), Varicella (chickenpox) (1)
- **Zoonotic Diseases:** Rabies, animal (2), Rabies, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (5)

**COVID-19:** To date, over 42 million cases of COVID-19, including at least 682,646 deaths, have been reported in the U.S., with community-wide transmission identified across the nation. The percent of the eligible U.S. population with at least one vaccination is 76.8%. Montana is reporting 146,035 cases of COVID-19 as of 11:30 am 9/24/2021. Of these, 7,330 individuals have been hospitalized and 1,945 have died. Additionally, Montana is reporting 989,268 total vaccine doses administered and processed into imMTrax. The total number of fully vaccinated persons is now 483,161. The percent of the eligible population that is fully vaccinated is 52%.

**West Nile Virus:** Montana has had **two cases** of WNV reported in **humans** this season. Both cases have been neuroinvasive disease. **Two equine cases** have been reported this year (Phillips, Richland). A total of **eleven** positive mosquito pools have been identified this season. Counties with positive mosquito pools include Blaine, Gallatin, McCone, Prairie, Richland, Rosebud, and Sheridan. Twenty-seven counties have had mosquito pools tested for WNV. As of September 21<sup>st</sup>, 2021 a total of 479 WNV cases, 135 presumptive viremic blood donors, and 21 deaths have been reported **nationally**.
