Summary of MMWR Week 43 for the state of Montana: Ending 10/30/2021

- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (7), Giardiasis (1), Salmonellosis (7)
- **General Communicable Diseases:** Latent TB Infection (LTBI) (2), Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome (MIS) COVID-19 (1)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis B, chronic (1), Hepatitis C, acute (2), Hepatitis C, chronic (9)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (70), Gonorrhea (31), Syphilis, primary or secondary (4)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** *Streptococcus pneumoniae*, invasive (3),
- **Vector Borne Diseases:** Lyme disease (1)
- **Zoonotic Diseases:** Rabies, animal (1), Rabies, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (3)

COVID-19: To date, over 46 million cases of COVID-19, including at least 747,970 deaths, have been reported in the U.S., with community-wide transmission identified across the nation. The percent of the eligible U.S. population 12+ with at least one vaccination is 78.4%. Montana is reporting 180,452 cases of COVID-19 as of 11:00am 11/05/2021. Of these, 9,123 individuals have been hospitalized and 2,415 have died. To date, Montana is reporting 1,125,998 total vaccine doses administered and processed into imMTrax. The total number of fully vaccinated persons is now 508,619. The percent of the eligible population that is fully vaccinated is 55%.

Influenza: Weekly Flu Data – Week 43:

- Influenza A tests run: 1125; No positives
- Influenza B tests run: 1126; No positives
- Percentage of outpatient and ED visits for ILI in MT: 1.45%
- RSV tests run: 241; 48 positive tests were reported (**19.92%** positivity rate)

All positive flu tests must go to the state for confirmatory testing. If you are unsure how to submit a sample for confirmatory testing at the MTPHL, please contact the Health Department at 406-582-3100. As of November 8th, we have 1 confirmed positive influenza A case in Gallatin County, and 2 results pending.
