Summary of MMWR Week 51 for the state of Montana

- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (2), Cryptosporidiosis (1), Giardiasis (1), Salmonellosis (1), Shiga toxin producing *E coli* [STEC] (1)
- **General Communicable Diseases:** Latent TB infection (LTBI) (3)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis C, acute (1), Hepatitis C, chronic (11)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (72), Gonorrhea (24), Syphilis, primary or secondary (2), HIV/AIDS (1)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** Influenza hospitalization (9), *Streptococcus pneumoniae*, invasive (2), Pertussis (1)
- **Zoonotic Diseases:** Rabies, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (1)
- **Vector Borne Diseases:** Lyme Disease (1 acquired out of state)

Omicron Variant: As of December 29, 2021, there have been 15 cases infected with omicron variants detected in Montana. These cases were detected in 8 counties: Cascade, Gallatin, Glacier, Hill, Jefferson, Missoula, Pondera, and Yellowstone.

Flu Update – Week 51: As of January 3, 2022 Gallatin County continues to have the most confirmed cases of Flu in the state (**446 Influenza A, 8 Influenza B**).
