Summary of MMWR Week 3 for the state of Montana:

- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (1), Giardiasis (2), Shiga toxin- producing *Escherichia coli* [STEC] (2), Cryptosporidiosis (1), Salmonellosis (1)
- **General Communicable Diseases:** Coccidioidomycosis (1), Elevated blood lead (2)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis C, chronic (14), Hepatitis C, acute (2)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (68), Gonorrhea (22), Syphilis, primary or secondary (1)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** Influenza, hospitalization or death (13), *Streptococcus pneumoniae*, invasive (1),
- **Zoonotic Diseases:** Rabies, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (1)

Influenza Update:

- Statewide Data: 233 new cases; 13 influenza-associated hospitalizations
- Percentage of outpatient and ED visits for Influenza-like-illness (ILI) in MT: 2.95% (National ILI visits: 2.75%; National baseline: 2.50%)

Influenza Notes Through MMWR Week 3, Ending 01/22.

- Total flu hospitalizations: 74
- Total flu/COVID-19 co-infection hospitalizations: 5
- Total flu-associated deaths: 1
- Total reported influenza cases in MT since October 1, 2021: 2599, primarily H3N2
