









Gallatin County Weekly Communicable Disease Report

- Additional summary of diseases reported in the state of Montana for MMWR Week 24:
 - **Enteric Diseases:** Cryptosporidiosis (2), Salmonellosis (3), Shiga toxin-producing *Escherichia coli* (STEC) (1)
 - **General Communicable Diseases:** Coccidioidomycosis (1), Legionellosis (1), Rabies post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (6)
 - **Heavy Metal Exposures:** Mercury (1)
 - **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis C, acute (1), Hepatitis C, chronic (25)
 - **STD/HIV:** Gonorrhea (19), HIV/AIDS (1), Syphilis, primary or secondary (3)
 - **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** *Haemophilus influenzae*, invasive (1), Pertussis (5), *Streptococcus pneumoniae*, invasive (2)
 - **Zoonoses:** Rabies, animal (1)
